CLPe Partners with Guangdong Weixin to Launch its First Integrated Energy as a Service Project in the Greater Bay Area

CLPe has signed a Build-Operate-Transfer (BOT) agreement with Guangdong Weixin Biological Technology Limited (Guangdong Weixin) to invest, build and run an integrated energy station that will provide chilled water, steam, and compressed air to Guangdong Weixin Bio-Intellectual Industrial Park in Qingyuan, Guangdong Province.

Guangdong Weixin is a leading food and nutritional supplement manufacturer that produces more than 2,000 products and works with top pharmaceutical brands. CLP*e* will fund, design, and construct the integrated energy station on the site provided by Weixin and will be responsible for its operation and maintenance under the 15-year BOT agreement signed in October this year. The station will supply chilled water, steam, and compressed air to meet the park's operational needs with a service fee paid by Guangdong Weixin. The partnership with Guangdong Weixin is CLP*e*'s first one-stop integrated energy as a service project in the Greater Bay Area (GBA).

Adopting a centralised design, the integrated energy station will be equipped with energy-saving chillers, industrial steam boilers, and air compressors to provide cooling, heating, and ventilation for the entire park, as well as heating energy and power to drive the production lines and different machinery. Its introduction will significantly improve the operational efficiency and energy efficiency of the industrial park.

Guangdong Weixin Director and General Manager Mr Zhang Jishun said, "Guangdong Weixin is committed to developing Guangdong Weixin Bio-intellectual Industrial Park as a demonstration of a smart, low-carbon, green park in support of the country's 'dual carbon goals'. We hope to achieve the sustainable development goals of Guangdong Weixin through our cooperation with CLPe."

CLPe Managing Director Mr Alex Keisser said, "This is our first integrated energy as a service project in the GBA. We customise energy-efficient solutions for Guangdong Weixin with our energy expertise and extensive experience, allowing customer to reduce

carbon emissions and develop its businesses in a sustainable manner." He emphasised that CLPe will continue to provide reliable, efficient and low-carbon energy solutions to support the sustainable development of commercial and industrial customers in the GBA.

Design work of the integrated energy station is currently under way, and construction is expected to begin in the first quarter of 2023.
